differences are observed, areas along the western part of North Africa, including Morocco and Tunisia, as well as certain areas in the northern and southern Arabian Peninsula covering countries such as Georgia, Azerbaijan, Syria, and Oman, exhibit high levels of public participation in WASH-related management. Moderate levels of local participation are evident across much of the central part of the region, encompassing countries like Lebanon, Jordan, Egypt, Sudan, Yemen, and Kuwait. Conversely, only a small section in the northeast, comprising Iraq, demonstrates low levels of public participation.
